Getting Started

Step 1: Ensure you have un-installed all previous Bluetooth devices!

Step 2: Install the Bluetooth Drivers from the CD enclosed and then Plug in your enclosed Bluetooth dongle.

Step 3: Go to www.idscan.co.uk/uk_downloads.php and download the Blue2 software on the machine you wish to use. Please note you will be required to connect the machine to the internet for the first time only to activate the software.

Step 3: Double Click this file to load Blue2



Image Toolbox

For the first time Users of Bluetooth technology will be able to create their artworks from within one single application. The Image Toolbox will allow you to design with ease.

Firstly you need to Click "Add Text", this will insert a text box in the preview window you can then type your text in the text window on the left hand side by clicking in the box. Using the Font, Size, Colour settings you can change the style of your text with ease.

Please note: You will have to click "Add Text" every time you want text on a new line.

You can click and drag on the individual text boxes to move them and position them as you wish. You can delete a text box by clicking on it and pressing delete.

If you wish to add a background image or simply change the background colour you can use the buttons located on the right hand side to select location of the image or colour of the background.

When you have finished with creating your image click save and specify a name. The default location for saving images will be "My Pictures".

Click Back to return to main menu.



Business Card Creator

With the business card creator you can send a V-Card along side your bluetooth message. It is simple and easy to use. Simply fill in as much or as little as you wish. When you have completed the fields click "Save", and your done.



Creating A New Campaign

To create a new campaign you need to ensure you have prepared your image that you wish to send out. You can use the in-built "Image Toolbox" to create your image or use an image from an external source.

Firstly give your campaign a name, for example "My Nightclub". Then select the location of your image. If you have used our Image Toolbox your image will be saved in "My Pictures". When you have completed that you have the option of inserting a business card. Business cards are in the format of ".vcf", you can use the business card creator to do this.

When completed click "Save Campaign".



Manage Your Campaigns

Select the campaign you created on the previous page using the drop down box in step 1. Then using the Start Date / Time and End Date / Time specify how long you wish to run this campaign for.

Select whether this campaign is Live by using step 3 and Click Start Campaign. The History box will show your statistics for previous transmissions.

You can repeat the above steps and create more than one campaign so the product will run itself. For example, My Nightclub operates different acts every hour and I would like to broadcast the acts as they happen. I create in the toolbox 4 images and in the campaign manager 4 campaigns. 6pm-7pm Joe Bloggs, 7pm-8pm Paul Matts, 8pm-9pm Amanda Jane, 9pm-10pm Happy Hour. When you click start campaign it will wait until 6pm before sending campaign 1 then at 7pm it will change and so on. When there are no campaigns left you will receive a message saying no active campaigns.





Monitor your campaigns

You may monitor your broadcasts on this screen you will see the amount of found phones increase as people become in range. The Blue2 program will work in the way you specify in the settings menu.

The image and campaign will change as time goes on depending on your settings on page 5.
